Subject: Polish Forced labour in Germany during the Second World War

Lesson aims – the student

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Lesson aims – the student

- clarifies the concept of forced labour,
- lists how Poles were recruited for work in the Reich,
- indicates where Poles are employed,
- lists the scope of workers' rights and obligations
- discusses Polish workers' basic living and working conditions
- clarifies the relationship between wartime conflict and labour acquisition

Learning Methods: assimilation of knowledge, independent and practical learning

Revision	<p>Message reminders:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- mention the most important events in Polish Second World War history- list the basic elements of German occupation policy in Poland- explain the changes in Poles' everyday life during the occupation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- revise their knowledge and skills
Focussing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- present lesson subject	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- notes the subject: Polish Forced labour in Germany during the Second World War

Developmental	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - discusses the history of Polish forced labour during the Second World War on the bases of a Power Point presentation, - presents exercise 1 instructions, controls the course of the exercise and checks correctness of students' performance, - presents exercise 2 and checks correctness of students' performance, - presents exercise 3 and checks correctness of students' performance. - , 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - listens to the lecture and makes notes for their own purposes - reads instructions, analyses map of Poland and indicates the direction of the forced deportation of Polish labour - analyses German propaganda leaflet and marks fragments encouraging Poles to go to work voluntarily, indicating their historical context - analyses photographs showing forced labourers
Summarising	<p>It summarises the topic and presents the phenomenon of forced labour in our own times.</p>	Writes most important information into the exercise folder
Homework assignment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To ask parents or grandparents about the fate of their family members during the war, with particular emphasis on their experience of forced labour. - To seek memorials or other forms of commemorating the War, especially for the victims of forced labour in the students local area. 	Becomes familiar with task content and asks questions
Evaluation	To encourage further	Makes their own evaluation activities and their own performance.
